Changes in staff:	Ben's role is now out of school club manager. 1 new nursery assistant 1 new casual member of staff in out of school club.
Developments to the setting since last assessment:	About to adopt seesaw to communicate with parents, have purchased kindle's and are waiting for consent forms to come back from parents. Successful with Denbighshire grant application and have bought a wooden pirate ship, sand pit, car and caravan for outside, a music board and for inside a kitchen area. Have bought a pass for Colwyn Bay Zoo, so visit regularly. Visit Wepre park and have been to Knowsley Safari Park. Held a firework display on bonfire night for families which was very successful, lots of families came with their children to support. New wild garden area developed with a bug hotel and rockery, plan to add more flowers with the children and bird houses etc.

Activities since last assessment:	
Nutrition & Oral Health:	Maintained compliance with minimum standards: ✓ L2 EY nutrition attended by cook, working towards Tiny Tums Best Practice Award. New soup's being trialled and new fruit based puddings. Children cook regularly. Themed menu's for events.
Hygiene:	Maintained compliance with minimum standards: ✓ Environmental health came this week – waiting for results. 1 x cleaner at the weekend, all staff responsible for cleaning their own rooms with checklists in place. Children use the glo bug regularly for lessons. Kiddi wash purchased for outside.
Mental & Emotional Health Wellbeing and Relationships:	World Book Day – Children dressed up and there was a themed menu. Celebrated St David's Day, Chinese New Year, Christmas etc. Children went on the spooky bus around Prestatyn. There is a rewards system in place in all rooms, and individual reward systems when needed. Helpur heddiw and circle time every day. Key Worker System in place.
Safety:	Allergen file created for the kitchen for children with allergies. Beep Beep Day Celebrated. Strange Danger talk before trips, hi vis vests worn on outings. Parents reminded to send in sun hats, and sunscreen or they have the option to pay for it. Risk assessments are reviewed updated on a regular basis.
Physical Activity/Active Play:	Afterschool club do boot camp and fitness activities and games every day. Pre school children do activity sessions with Ben including going outside and using the obstacle course. All weather clothes are provided so children can be active in all conditions. Indoors children are active using Jabadao, indoor soft play and sticky kids. The setting attended the walking festival in the community, they were joined by their families and planted sunflowers.
Environment:	Woodland Trail has been created in the garden, offering a space for children to explore and be in the natural environment. There are plans in place for the children to use the trail and the outdoor classroom much more when they are completed, children have been involved with all the plans for the outdoor areas. children have been making camp fires and have made sling shots for tin can 'alley'.

	A visit to Nant Y Glyn Forest school area in Conwy was a useful trip in the planning of the outdoor areas.
Workplace Health:	<p>Staff have recently been completing their self-appraisals ready for their appraisals.</p> <p>Team meetings are regular, sometimes team leaders have meetings and cascade to their staff. There is also a staff Whatsapp group.</p> <p>There are staff social events planned for occasions and Christmas and team building day is being planned.</p> <p>A pregnancy Health and Safety checklist has been added.</p>
