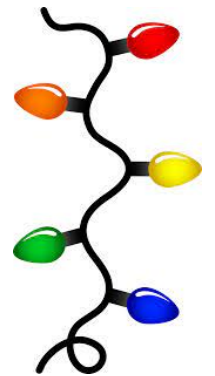
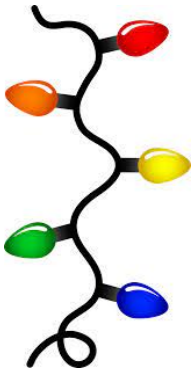

Christmas shut down.

As the nursery is closed for a full week over the Christmas period, it is not possible to swap any sessions. If attendance has been continuous since the previous September, these days can be banked and used throughout the following year. This is subject to your account being fully paid up on 1st January. The following refund entitlements during this period apply-

- Continuous full-time attendance since the previous June will be entitled to a 50% refund.
- Continuous full-time attendance since the previous September will be entitled to 25% refund.

Unfortunately, there is no refund entitlement if your child has been in full time attendance for less than three months. All refunds must be applied for in writing from 1st February and are subject to your account being fully paid up over the Christmas period.



- Nursery will close at 6pm on Friday 22nd December 2023 and reopen at 7am on Tuesday 2nd January 2024
- Flying Start and 30 hour funded children, will be funded from 2nd January (Tuesday) 2024.
- Early Entitlement 10 hour funded children, will be funded from 8th January (Monday) 2024.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank you all for your continued support throughout 2023, we have had an extremely busy and productive year and have lots of exciting plans for 2024!
