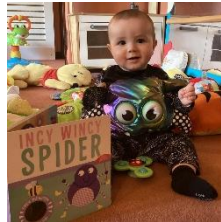
We also got creative by making our own pancakes using playdough. The children rolled, shaped and added their favourite “toppings,” using their imaginations while developing their fine motor skills.
